

The vet will review your **pet's** health and lifestyle, and will then only give the vaccines which are judged to be **necessary**. In the United Kingdom, for most **dogs**, the recommendation is likely to be a once **yearly** vaccine against Leptospirosis, with a **booster** against Distemper, Hepatitis and Parvovirus every three years.²⁵ Apr 2013

PET VACCINATION SCHEDULE: PUPPY

Vaccine	Schedule	Booster	Immunity Duration (estimated)
Distemper	At 6 to 8 weeks, 9 to 11 weeks, and 12 to 14 weeks	1 year after last puppy dose, then every 1 to 3 years depending on vaccine type	1 to 7 years depending on initial vaccine used
Parvovirus	At 6 to 8 weeks, 9 to 11 weeks, and 12 to 14 weeks	Same as above	Same as above
Adenovirus	At 6 to 8 weeks, 9 to 11 weeks, and 12 to 14 weeks	1 year after last puppy dose, then every 3 years	At least 7 years
Rabies	3 months	1 year after puppy dose, then as mandated by local authorities	3 years
