

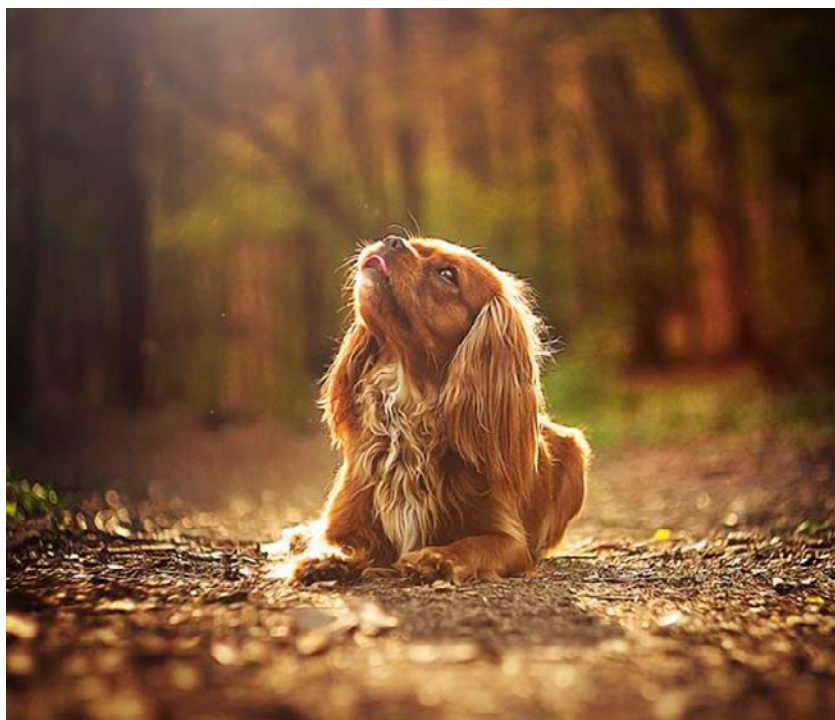

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Project launched to improve Syringomyelia in the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel

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This ambitious five-year project aims to collect vital data on syringomyelia, a serious neurological condition, to inform breeding strategies and improve the long-term health of Cavaliers.

The project has been made possible through generous funding from The Kennel Club Charitable Trust (KCCT), Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Rescue & Welfare, and the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, demonstrating the community's commitment to the health of this much-loved breed.

Syringomyelia is caused by fluid-filled cavities developing in the spinal cord, often due to abnormalities in the skull and neck area. Affected dogs may experience symptoms such as neck pain, sensitivity, reluctance to jump, and phantom scratching. In severe cases, the condition can lead to weakness and mobility issues.

British Veterinary Association President, Dr. Elizabeth Mullineaux, said: "Syringomyelia can be a distressing condition, and improving our understanding of its prevalence and inheritance is essential for improving health outcomes for dogs affected by it. This project will provide valuable insights, ultimately leading to better breeding guidance for Cavalier King Charles Spaniels."

The project aims to screen 500 Cavaliers over five years through MRI scans, with the intention for the data to be used to develop Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs). EBVs are a valuable

tool for breeders as they consider multiple genetic factors, helping to inform breeders on how to reduce the prevalence of complex inherited conditions.

Michael Levy, Chairman of the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, commented: "The Cavalier Club continues to support initiatives that promote the health and wellbeing of our breed. To have a breed-specific project that will give an opportunity to understand the prevalence of syringomyelia, along with breeding guidelines, will aid for healthier outcomes for the breed.

We thank The Kennel Club and the British Veterinary Association for introducing this project. The Club's financial contribution shows the importance and commitment we give to a healthier future for the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel."

Participation in the project is by invitation - dogs are selected based on their age and genetic contribution to the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel population. To encourage participation, owners of selected dogs will benefit from a significant subsidy towards MRI screening, thanks to the support of the KCCT, Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Rescue & Welfare, and the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club. Instead of the typical cost of an MRI, which ranges from £1,100 to £4,500, owners will pay £200 to participate in the project.

Charlotte McNamara, Head of Health and Breeder Development at The Kennel Club, added: "This project is a major step forward in our efforts to reduce the prevalence of syringomyelia in



Cavaliers. By gathering robust data, with the potential of developing EBVs, we can support breeders in making informed decisions to protect future generations of this breed. We are incredibly grateful to The Kennel Club Charitable Trust, Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, and Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Rescue & Welfare for their support and commitment."

Selected dog owners will receive an invitation from The Kennel Club, with the first invitations sent in March 2025. They can book MRI appointments at participating centres, and the expert panel will review the results. DNA samples will also be collected during MRI appointments to support genetic research into syringomyelia.

The Kennel Club takes insights from its health data and feeds them into its Breed Health and Conservation plans, so that it can work with breeders to give information and guidance about how to ensure the future health of pedigree breeds. These plans, which enable The Kennel Club to track progress and make meaningful changes to breed health, have been developed as a result of reviewing more than 4,000 research papers, making the project the most comprehensive review of pedigree health data anywhere in the world. Our Crufts report delves into the numbers and celebrates the record number of overseas dogs entered, especially as six out of the eight group placings went to dogs who had travelled from overseas with Italy taking the overall best Hound and best Terrier, and a day later Croatia took best Utility – demonstrating the appeal of Crufts worldwide.

We bring you a round-up of Crufts news, spot the stars amongst the Crufts crowds, highlight the most viral videos on TikTok, health testing from our busy

veterinary team and a Hamiltonstovare enthusiast with a close connection to the breed makes his debut on the Crufts Discover Dogs stand. Last year the Polish Hunting Dog received breed recognition and made its debut in Crufts Discover Dogs and was part of the press launch with Ellie Simmonds OBE. Two breeds that received championship status last year crowned their first Champion at Crufts, one of which was the Terrier group winner, the breeds that pulled in the largest entry, charity donations and our younger visitors celebrated World Book Day on Thursday 6 March on the Bark and Read stand.

There were a few anniversaries being celebrated this Crufts, including the 70th anniversary of the Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier Club of Great Britain and Bearded Collie Club. The 140th anniversary of the Irish Wolfhound Club. Dave Raymond, West Midlands Police Dog Unit Breed Scheme Manager, celebrated his 20th Crufts and Cathy Guiver, The Kennel Club's Head of Events and Helen Fox, The Kennel Club's Chief Commercial Officer, who work tirelessly behind the scenes to make Crufts a successful event celebrated 30 years of Crufts. It was also the 20th year of The Kennel Club Good Citizen Dog Training scheme Special Pre-Beginner Obedience Stakes final that has been held at Crufts. Sadly, we said goodbye to two very special people who carry out official duties at Crufts, Bill Lambert, Executive for Health, Welfare and Breeder Services and Professor Emeritus Peter Bedford, part of the Crufts veterinary team. They enjoyed their last Crufts before retirement and will be greatly missed.

In our show review we meet the winners of the Best Breed Club Stand and Best Discover Dogs Stand awards – some retaining their title for another year and who all work diligently to man their stand over the four days. Our public affairs team were kept busy showing politicians around the event and we meet the hoopers team of 2025 – back for a second year demonstrating their display

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in the BP Pulse LIVE Arena. We cover the first Sustainable Exhibitor awards by Agria Pet Insurance and outline how Crufts has become cleaner and greener this year. Two of our editorial team report on their judging appointments and what it means to judge at this prestigious event, one panel member got back behind the lead of a breed she hasn't judged for 38 years, and two members unable to attend the show, watched the extensive coverage on Channel 4, that incredibly attracted over eight million people over the four days!

Medical Detection Dogs, once again, presented another enthralling display in the BP Pulse LIVE Arena and they announced the results from a ground-breaking study that revealed whether cancer detection dogs can smell bladder cancer in other dog's urine. West Midlands Police Dog Unit ramped up the action with their police dog display and three-year-old PD Oreo demonstrated her excellent skills as a fully licenced digital media search dog, and we meet the winners of the BASC's gamekeepers' classes as well as our working dogs in the impressive gundog display.

It's evident that this year's show was a resounding success and the phenomenal attraction of Crufts is shown in the ticket sales with a gate of over 155,000 – it certainly is the show that every dog lover wants to attend.



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The Kennel Club expands use of champion classes to all open and championship shows

Due to the popularity of champion classes at breed club shows, The Kennel Club is expanding the option to include them at all open and championship shows. This change, which will apply to single breed, group or general shows comes into effect immediately, though it remains optional.

The Show Executive Committee approved this expansion at a meeting recently. The introduction of champion classes at breed club championship

shows dates back to 2018, following a recommendation from the Dog Show Promotion Working Party. These classes have been a popular addition to many breed club shows and it is hoped that it may help increase entries.

Including a champions class at any open or championship show is entirely at the society's discretion and is not compulsory. The new option applies to single breed, group or general shows. The champion class is the same as any

other class and the winning dog or bitch, provided it is unbeaten, can challenge for best of sex, relevant Challenge Certificate and Best of Breed. There is no requirement that a champion has to be entered in a champions class.

Any queries regarding the addition of champions classes should be emailed to dogshows@thekennelclub.org.uk. If a club or society has already issued and published a schedule - it cannot be amended to include this class.

Automation of endorsements

The Kennel Club has introduced a new endorsement application process and would like to reassure that there is no change as to who can lift an endorsement, which will still remain with the person(s) who placed the endorsement.

Reasons for change:

- More secure and streamlined online process – endorers (i.e. breeder) no longer need to upload signed letters; instead, they complete an online form, making the application process more secure and efficient.
- In instances where a breeder registers a litter and has placed an endorsement on a puppy/litter, the endorsement can only be lifted by those breeder(s).
- Should an owner apply to remove an endorsement that they have not placed on behalf of a breeder, this will be rejected and they will be referred back to the person who placed the endorsement.
- Where there are joint endorers (i.e. breeders), all endorers will be notified via email to ensure transparency of any request to remove/place an endorsement. They will be given seven days to approve or object which will reduce unauthorised changes.
- Faster processing times for breeder requests and instructions

Previously, persons who placed an endorsement were required to submit a signed letter when applying for endorsement changes, which often led to frustration due to scanning or uploading challenges. The Kennel Club has developed a new online process whereby breeders (not owners) will simply consent to a declaration confirming they have the necessary signed consent to remove/place an endorsement, eliminating the need for document uploads during the application.

As part of this streamlined approach, any joint endorers, not the new owners, will automatically be notified by email of an application and given a seven-day window to approve or object to the placing or removal of an endorsement. If all parties approve within the period, or if no response is received, the placing or lifting of the endorsement will be processed automatically. In the event of an objection by one of the other endorers, the application will be declined. As is currently the process, in this scenario the endorers will need to resolve any concerns between themselves directly.

Said Helen Fox, Chief Commercial Officer: "We hope this new streamlined process will significantly enhance the endorsement service and improve the

experience for breeders and owners. The Kennel Club is dedicated to becoming a digitally-first organisation, with the goal of making all our products and services seamless, accessible and aligned with the demands of the modern world and customer needs. With this new online system, we will be working towards an online service only and we kindly ask our breeders to no longer send in postal applications for endorsements.

"The Kennel Club remains committed to continuously improving our services, and this change marks an important step forward in modernising the endorsement application process and providing a more secure and controlled process for breeders. It not only improves our operations but also supports our goal of becoming more sustainable and advancing in a digital direction."

As The Kennel Club continues to automate and digitise this process, it urges customers to ensure online accounts are up to date with the latest information including email addresses. Keeping accounts current is the best way to ensure customers receive important notifications. Breeders are also encouraged to plan ahead and apply to remove endorsements in a timely manner to help avoid delays when registering litters.

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German Pinscher given championship status

Following the recent announcement of three new breeds given championship status, The Kennel Club Board has agreed to allocate championship status to a further breed from 2026, the German Pinscher.

The German Pinscher will join the Bolognese, Coton de Tulear and the Japanese Akita Inu in being allocated Challenge Certificates (CCs) from this date.

The following shows have been allocated CCs from 2026:

GERMAN PINSCHER

• Crufts, National Working and Pastoral Breeds Society and the German Pinscher Club.

The breed clubs will be asked to hold their championship show at least one month apart from Crufts and the relevant group show if possible, to ensure as wide a spread of CCs throughout the year as possible. The breed club championship show must not be held before Crufts in 2026.

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New DNA testing schemes for the Manchester Terrier and English Toy Terrier

The Kennel Club has approved two new official DNA testing schemes for juvenile dilated cardiomyopathy (JDCM) and xanthinuria (type 2) in both the Manchester Terrier and English Toy Terrier (Black & Tan).

JDCM is a heart condition that affects dogs early in life (around six months of age), and can result in sudden death following exercise or surgery.

Xanthinuria results from the inability of the body to properly manage waste products of the urine, resulting in the build of xanthine crystals within the urinary tract, and potential kidney damage over time.

The two diseases are believed to be autosomal-recessive conditions. This means that dogs that inherit two copies of the gene mutation (one from its mother and one from its father) will have an increased risk of developing the condition.

Tested dogs will be recorded on The Kennel Club systems as either:

CLEAR

CARRIER

AFFECTED

The dog has two copies of the abnormal gene associated with the disease. The dog will likely be clinically affected by the disorder and will pass one copy of the abnormal gene on to any potential offspring.

Test results will be added to the dog's registration details which will trigger the publication of the result in the next available Breed Records Supplement and also on the Health Test Results Finder on The Kennel Club website.

Results for dogs already tested can also be recorded, but owners will need to submit copies of the DNA certificates themselves. DNA test certificates should be scanned and emailed to health.results@thekennelclub.org.uk.

At this time, the tests will be listed under the Health Standard's Best Practice category for the two breeds, with a grace-period of six months to allow owners to reach Best Practice before the guidelines are formally introduced for Find a Puppy.

The Kennel Club's Health Standard consolidates all relevant health tests for a breed in one place, providing clear guidance on which tests to undertake before breeding and how to do so. The Good Practice category highlights the most critical tests as a starting point, while all breeders are encouraged to aim for the Best Practice level by completing all recommended tests. Assignment of a test to Good/Best Practice categories is fluid, and depends on a number of factors, including the relevance of the test to the breed, the prevalence of the disease and how trends in prevalence have changed over time.

The Kennel Club constantly reviews DNA testing schemes in conjunction with breed clubs to ensure that breeders are supported with resources which help them to make responsible breeding decisions. The Kennel Club works alongside breed clubs and breed health coordinators in a collaborative effort to improve the health of pedigree dogs and is happy to consider a club's request to add a new DNA test to its lists. A formal request from the breed's health coordinator or a majority request from the breed clubs is normally required to do this.

The Kennel Club takes insights from its health data and feeds them into its Breed Health and Conservation plans, so that it can work with breeders to give information and guidance about how to ensure the future health of pedigree breeds. These plans, which enable The Kennel Club to track progress and make meaningful changes to breed health, have been developed as a result of reviewing more than 4,000 research papers, making the project the most comprehensive review of pedigree health data anywhere in the world. 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New DNA testing scheme for the Keeshond

The Kennel Club has approved a new official DNA testing scheme for primary hyperparathyroidism (PHPT) in the Keeshond.

The disease is believed to be an autosomal-dominant condition. This means that a dog need only inherit one copy of an abnormal gene (either from its mother or its father) before its health is affected.

Tested dogs will be recorded on The Kennel Club systems as either:

CLEAR

These dogs do not have any copies of the abnormal gene associated with the condition that has been tested for. These dogs are highly unlikely to develop this condition and will pass on a normal copy of the gene to their puppies

SINGLE AFFECTED

These dogs have one copy of the normal gene and one copy of the abnormal gene associated with the condition that has been tested for. These dogs will likely be affected by the disorder and could pass on a copy of the abnormal gene on to any future puppies

DOUBLE AFFECTED

These dogs have two copies of the abnormal gene associated with the condition that has been tested for. These dogs will likely be affected by the disorder and will pass on one copy of the abnormal gene on to any future puppies

Test results will be added to the dog's registration details which will trigger the publication of the result in the next



available Breed Records Supplement and also on the Health Test Results Finder on The Kennel Club website.

We do need ethical breeders who understand and prioritise health and good husbandry, and their vets can play an important part in achieving this. A good relationship is not only helpful for the vet and the breeder; importantly, it also improves animal welfare."

Disciplinary Committee

20 February 2025

Three Ridings Labrador Club Novice Trial – 9 November 2024

Mr J Christon and Mrs R Thistle

MRS REBECCA THISTLE

Challenged and confronted the Judge, Mr Jim Christon and started arguing after you were eliminated from the Trial.

MR JAMES CHRISTON

Made personalised and insulting comments to Mrs Thistle which she found upsetting and distressing.

The Committee reviewed all the statements and noted the following.

- Mr Christon had to eliminate Mrs Thistle from the Trial after retrieval of a bird from an incorrect area. After he did so, Mrs Thistle began arguing about that decision. Mrs Thistle said in a confrontational manner 'We will have words about this later'.
- Mrs Thistle continued to dispute the result even after Trial had ended. Mrs Thistle confronted Mr Christon when the various participants were making their way back to their cars and to argue about the elimination.
- Mrs Thistle's account is that she maintains that she did not intend to question Mr Christon's decision, but had no chance to speak at the point when eliminated. Mrs Thistle offered to shake hands with Mr Christon, and explained

that he refused and instead subjected her to rude and abusive remarks about her alleged 'bad reputation' amongst the Field Trial community.

- The Committee's view was that Mrs Thistle may have misconstrued the remarks and comments made by Mr Christon. There is no evidence that this was intended as personally directed. Mr Christon explains that he wanted to point out to her that the continual challenges over decisions was being noticed and that the manner of her engagement about decisions needs to be modified.

The Disciplinary Committee did not uphold the complaint from Mrs Thistle against Mr Christon.

When a competitor has been eliminated from a Field Trial, it is acceptable to respectfully ask the Judge for an explanation for an elimination after the event has ended, with the aim of improving future performance in competition. However, it is not acceptable for a competitor to overtly dispute the outcome with the Judge, either at the point of elimination, or afterwards - nor to do so in a confrontational, or disrespectful manner.

The Disciplinary Committee considered there had been a breach of regulation by Mrs Thistle and confirmed the following penalties in respect of the incident;

1. To warn about future conduct
2. To censure Mrs Thistle
3. To impose a fine of £100

It was felt that the warning should be accompanied by a yellow card. To allow for reparation and moderation of conduct going forward.

20 February 2025

Dukeries [Notts] Gundog Club Open HPR Stake – 16 September 2024

MR GEOFF SAINT

Mr Saint was a competitor in the above Trial, at which Mr Simon Kirby was the A Panel Judge. Mr Saint impugned the judge's decision to eliminate him and was confrontational in challenging the decision.

The Committee reviewed all the statements and noted the following:

- Mr Saint's dog struggled to take direction, such that Mr Saint was eliminated from the Trial. Because Mr Saint did not then leave the scene, Mr Kirby explained to him that he had been eliminated because his dog had not picked a bird, despite being in the right area. Mr Saint challenged Mr Kirby and said he did not know the rules and said 'I will see you later' in an intimidating tone.
- In response, Mr Saint has said that when he arrived at the Trial, he was well-mannered and respectful towards Mr Kirby. When he was subsequently eliminated, Mr Saint says he disagreed with the outcome, but respected the Judge's decision. He told Mr Kirby the two of them would speak again later, because he didn't want to disrupt the running of the Trial. Overall, Mr Saint denies the allegations of what happened on the day.

When a competitor has been eliminated from a Field Trial, it is acceptable to respectfully ask the Judge to explain the reason for the elimination, but only after an event has ended and with the aim of improving future performance in competition. However, it is neither acceptable for a competitor to overtly dispute the outcome with the Judge, at the point of elimination or afterwards, nor to do so in a confrontational or disrespectful manner.

The Disciplinary Committee considered there had been a breach of regulation by

Mr Saint and confirmed the following penalties in respect of the incident:

1. To warn Mr Saint about his future conduct
2. To censure Mr Saint
3. To impose a fine of £100.00

It was felt that the warning should be accompanied by a Yellow card, to allow for reparation and moderation of conduct going forward.

J.8.b. 13

The Kennel Club's Codes of Conduct specify the sort of behaviour expected of those who take part in competitive gundog work. All participants should be aware of the Codes of Conduct and must abide by them, and by Kennel Club Regulations, and, in particular, should never publicly impugn decisions of the judge or judges. Neither should they criticise the host, ground or guns.

DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

YELLOW AND RED CARDS UPDATE

1. The Yellow and Red Card measure was introduced to support early informal warnings in response to complaints brought under the Kennel Club Code of Conduct. The measure is targeted towards conduct relating to participation at licensed events - to include related social media engagement.
2. All complaints matter, and the impact of thoughtless or deliberate action or comment is not to be underestimated. There are a range of outcomes to reflect an incident and it is not always possible to issue high end penalties in the first instance.
3. Outcomes for conduct complaints may include; informal or formal warning with/without a Yellow card, censure and fines up to £300. For more serious/high end incidents (or serial behaviours) disqualifications from Kennel Club regulated activities may be imposed under Kennel Club Rule A11
4. Yellow cards may be issued by the conduct complaints team to support informal warnings. The Disciplinary Committee has recently reviewed some cases and wished to support the formal warnings issued with a Yellow card.
5. Where a Yellow card is issued to support an informal warning the expectation is that behaviours will be moderated and it is not intended that the issue of a Yellow card will be published. If the Disciplinary Committee issues a Yellow card to support a formal warning then that will be published as part of the overall decision.

6. A yellow card may be converted to a Red card if there is repetition of an incident and that will result in a refusal of entry being imposed to all licensed events for a fixed period of time. In the future, in exceptional cases, a Red card may be issued immediately.

A Red card may also be used as a suspending measure due to external investigations.

The routes to complain about conduct or social media issues include; i) Kennel Club Code of

Conduct/regulation arising from participation at licensed events; ii) where an individual holds a representative position eg KC Member (Kennel Club Code) or judge (Code of Best Practice for Judges); iii) serious or serial conduct – Rule A11.

'Online bashing'

Where any participant criticises licensed events, show/event organisers and judges, other exhibitors or their dogs in inappropriate, hurtful or excessive ways on social media this will be reviewed under

the conduct regulation for the respective licensed canine activity and will include the use of the Yellow/Red card measures where appropriate.

There is a personal responsibility if private and personal opinions are to be made public.

It is important not to deliberately or inadvertently be the catalyst for a conversation which degenerates into harsh and hurtful content. Yellow/Red cards will be considered where social media posting or engagement crosses an acceptable threshold.
