Crufts 2026 is set to welcome an impressive 18,698 dogs to the NEC Birmingham from 5-8 March, marking a notable rise of 123 entries on Crufts 2025. The world's greatest celebration of dogs continues to thrive, with the vast majority of exhibitors proudly homegrown from across the UK, while also achieving a record-breaking level of international participation.

More than 200 pedigree breeds will compete for the coveted Best in Show title, to be awarded live on Channel 4 on Sunday 8 March in the bp pulse LIVE arena. Audiences can enjoy 17.5 hours of Crufts coverage across Channel 4 and More4, showcasing the very best of British dog breeding, training and handling alongside the event's vibrant global community.

This year's show reinforces Crufts' international appeal, attracting 4,299 overseas entries – the highest in the event's history. France leads the international contingent with 538 dogs, followed by Italy (436), Germany (425) and the Netherlands (353). Strong entries have also come from Ireland (335), Poland (288), the Czech Republic (231), Belgium (227), Sweden (180) and Spain (166), each contributing to the event's growing global reach. At the other end of the scale, there are 14 countries represented by a single competitor with dedicated entrants

travelling from as far away as New Zealand, Peru and Argentina.

Crufts 2026 is celebrating a particularly encouraging turnout for the 39 British and Irish native breeds listed as vulnerable, with an impressive 2,602 dogs entered across the breed rings. At a time when these historic breeds face declining population numbers, such a strong presence highlights the dedication of UK breeders, owners and enthusiasts who are working hard to secure their future. Just some of the vulnerable breed entries include 100 Miniature Bull Terriers, 66 Greyhounds, 124 English Setters and 104 Old English Sheepdogs – all testament to the growing commitment to preserving the nation's canine heritage. Their visibility on the world's biggest dog stage offers an invaluable opportunity to raise awareness, inspire new admirers and support the long term survival of these much loved native breeds.

The Labrador Retriever tops the table with the highest entry in the show with 547 dogs making 586 entries, up 62 on last year. Close behind, the Golden Retriever continues its popularity with 529 dogs making 608 entries, maintaining its position as one of Crufts' most beloved breeds. The Komondor has the fewest number of dogs entered with 3 dogs represented.

The highest number of dogs in a single breed set to compete in each group are:

- **Working:** Siberian Husky - 156
- **Pastoral:** Border Collie - 310
- **Terrier:** Staffordshire Bull Terrier - 393
- **Hound:** Whippet - 403
- **Utility:** Dalmatian - 265
- **Toy:** Cavalier King Charles Spaniel - 282
- **Gundog:** Labrador Retriever - 547

Additionally, the following breeds have dogs exceeding 250; Cocker Spaniel (409), Flat Coated Retriever (330), and Shetland Sheepdog (265).

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The Obedience Championships for dogs will be held on Saturday, with bitches competing on Sunday. In Agility, the Small and Medium Championships take place on Thursday while the Intermediate and Large Championships on the Sunday.

For the first time, the Hungarian Mudi, Icelandic Sheepdog and Pyrenean Mastiff will feature in the Discover Dogs area of the show as newly recognised Royal Kennel Club breeds.



Highlights in the bp pulse LIVE arena include the Royal Kennel Club Hero Dog Award, celebrating dogs that provide lifetime service, support, love and devotion, and the final of the nation's favourite crossbreed competition, Scruffts.

Tom Mather, Crufts Chairman, said: "The increase in entries for Crufts 2026 shows just how powerfully this event continues to resonate with dog lovers across the world. Welcoming more than 18,600 dogs - including a record number from overseas - is a remarkable testament to Crufts' global appeal and the passion of our incredible community. From first time exhibitors to long standing competitors, the enthusiasm is palpable, and we can't wait to celebrate the very best of dogs, dedication and joyful competition this March."

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Royal Kennel Club reveals 2026 roadmap to a new future for dog breeding

'A new future for dog breeding' moves into action and collaboration to ensure views of breeding community are at the foundation of RKC plans

The Royal Kennel Club, the UK's oldest and most respected dog organisation has released further plans which aim to ensure a new future for pedigree dog breeding, by revealing the roadmap for the Breeding for Health Framework for 2026. On publication of the report in January, the RKC outlined its commitment to ensuring the pedigree breeder community was fully immersed in the development of the nose-to-tail veterinary assessment, the small populations working group and the mandatory health testing process.

The Nose to Tail Veterinary Assessment will sit alongside, and provide a viable alternative to, AGPAW's Innate Health Assessment (IHA), aimed specifically for the RKC breeding community. Development of the veterinary assessment is already underway, with the veterinary advisory group having already held a series of planned meetings and aiming to select the criteria for inclusion in this assessment by late March.

Following the launch of the BFHF, and in recognition of the strength of feeling and concern amongst the community regarding the IHA and broader breeding challenges, representatives from the RKC met with a select group of RKC members and experienced breeders on Thursday 29 January, who provided valuable insight on key issues and challenges facing breeders.

These insights, together with additional feedback received from the wider RKC community, members and key stakeholders, have helped shape the agenda for the Crufts Breeder Insights Forum, which will be held from 3-5pm on Thursday 5 March in the Piazza Suites 1 & 2 at the NEC. While the full agenda will be released shortly, this session will be an opportunity for experienced breeders, especially those concerned about the

recent publicity around the IHA, to share their views and help shape the solutions that will be developed by the RKC in the coming months. We look forward to continuing the conversation and listening to breeders to enable us to build a strong that addresses breeder concerns beyond the Breeding for Health Framework.

The successful development of our Nose to Tail Veterinary Assessment is dependent on the involvement of breeders, and therefore we would like to ensure breeders are aware and sign up to the breed focus groups, ideally in collaboration with their breed health co-ordinator. Details of these focus groups and how to join can be found below, in addition to details of further activities we will be undertaking in the coming months to support breeders.

Ian Seath, Chairman of The Royal Kennel Club, says, "The strength of the Royal Kennel Club lies in its community. By working closely with breeders and

listening carefully to their views, we are building a forward-looking approach to health and welfare that reflects both scientific rigour and the realities of responsible breeding."

Charlotte McNamara, the Royal Kennel Club's Head of Health and Breeding, says, "The depth of feeling we've seen in recent months from our community and the concerns raised by breeders underscores just how strongly many people care about the future of pedigree dogs. When we published our Breeding for Health Framework recently, we made a commitment to ensure our viable alternative to the IHA would be developed in collaboration with vets and breeders, particularly breeders of breeds who stand to be most affected if left unchallenged. We are therefore happy to confirm the details of our next phase of development and look forward to working with and are thankful for the breadth of knowledge and experience we can access within our membership and broader breeding community."

A new future for dog breeding - what's coming up

Early February 2026 – the RKC launches a breeder endorsements survey to consider what we should do with endorsements to best support breeders and puppy buyers moving into the future.

End of February 2026 – the RKC will introduce a new puppy buyer feedback process to enable breeders to receive direct feedback which recognises their hard work and commitment.

16 March 2026 – following the activities taking place during

Crufts, the RKC will launch breeder insights survey to the wider breeding community, building on the information shared and issues raised to date.

23 March and 25 March 2026 – the RKC will hold the first in a series of focus groups with breeders to seek input on the development of the Nose-to-Tail Veterinary Assessment and capture feedback on concerns around the IHA. 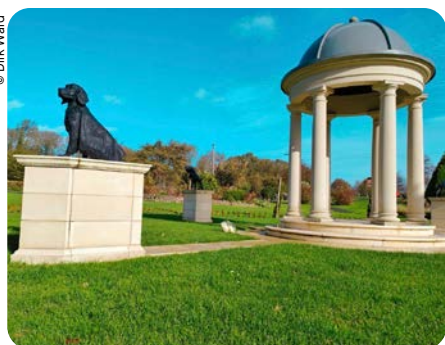
Our breed of the month is the White Swiss Shepherd Dog (Imp), that was only granted breed status by The Kennel Club in October 2017.



Intelligent, versatile and distinctive in its white coat, the breed traces its roots to early German Shepherd Dog lines and has overcome decades of exclusion to become a gentle and much-admired family companion. The Breed Health Co-ordinator reviews last year's registration figures and the breed's rising popularity, underlining the need for responsible, ethical breeding and welfare. This is followed by the hard work of the breed's rescue and re-homing team, providing guidance for anyone wishing to rehome, foster or adopt.

We celebrate the breed's recent string of awards at Crufts' Discover Dogs, where White Swiss Shepherds delight visitors. Enthusiasts also share stories of dogs excelling in activities ranging from therapy work to achieving important first milestones in the show ring. The breed club take us on a scenic walk at Shipley Country Park, Derbyshire and three judges reveal their three favourite White Swiss Shepherd Dogs judged in the ring.

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RFG scheme expanded with free health testing available at Crufts 2026 for an additional 14 breeds

The Royal Kennel Club has announced an expansion to its existing Respiratory Function Grading (RFG) scheme, in partnership with the University of Cambridge, which will see free health testing at Crufts extended to a further 14 breeds. The expansion has been enabled due to the publication of a new peer-reviewed research paper by Cambridge University, which evaluates Brachycephalic Obstructive Airway Syndrome (BOAS) prevalence and severity across 14 additional breeds using the existing RFG methodology.

Following the Kennel Club Charitable Trust (KCCT) funding of the BOAS research group at the University of Cambridge in 2010, the resulting publications underpinned the development of the Respiratory Function Grading Scheme (RFGS) for Bulldogs, French Bulldogs and Pugs. In 2021, additional BOAS research was funded by the KCCT and the new research, led by Dr Fran Tomlinson under the supervision of Professor Jane Ladlow, is a subsequent study undertaken to determine whether the same evidence-led framework could be applied to other breeds, 14 breeds researched in total.

Publication of the paper confirms that the evidence-based framework behind the RFGS can be expanded beyond the three original breeds to those included in the study, providing a standardised mechanism for data collection across a wider population. As of 18 February, the RFGS is available for the additional 14 breeds. Owners can find contact details for a list of trained veterinary assessors on the Royal Kennel Club website, www.royalkennelclub.com/rfgs. Additionally, from 5-7th March at Crufts, free testing will be available on a walk-up basis, in the relevant breed halls, with no advance booking required.

The study demonstrates a varying prevalence of brachycephalic obstructive airway syndrome (BOAS) across the breeds assessed. Some breeds showed no evidence of clinically significant disease, while others were found to have a higher proportion of affected dogs, with around 30-50% of dogs assessed in these breeds showing clinically significant signs.

The Royal Kennel Club has been working closely with the relevant breed communities to make sure the expanded RFGS is implemented in a way that supports each breed. Breed representatives have been engaged throughout the process, including a consultation period which began in October 2025, and will continue to be supported with breed-specific information and guidance as the scheme is rolled out. As part of the next scheduled update in June 2026, the Respiratory Function Grading Scheme will be added to the Health Standard for additional breeds, where appropriate and in line with the published methodology. The findings from the research, together with ongoing data collected through the expanded scheme, will help inform how respiratory health is addressed within each breed, including whether additional approaches are needed over time, in line with the Royal Kennel Club's recently published Breeding for Health Framework for 2026.

Charlotte McNamara, The Royal Kennel Club's Head of Health and Breeding, says, "This expansion is an evidence-led progression of RFGS and enables us to provide a practical, standardised tool to support informed breeding decisions to reduce BOAS prevalence over time in a wider group of breeds, while also enabling structured data collection across a

wider population. As a key element of our Breeding for Health Framework, we look forward to continuing to improve brachycephalic dog health and by working together with our community we can make a difference for dogs."

Liz Stannard, Breed Health Coordinator for Pekingese said, "We have been engaged with this research and are working closely with the RKC to ensure our community is both involved and supported. We welcome the expansion of the RFG scheme and will encourage our community to take part in testing to build strong data points and ultimately reduce the prevalence of BOAS in Pekingese."

Jane Conway, Breed Health Coordinator for Griffon Bruxellois said, "We are pleased to see the RFG Scheme being expanded to include Griffons and welcome the opportunity to use the scheme to collect further data on our population. We hope this will support ongoing monitoring and help drive continued improvement for the breed."

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Top vulnerable breeds to compete at Crufts 2026

The names of the dogs which will compete in the final of the Royal Kennel Club Vulnerable British and Irish Native Breeds Final at Crufts 2026 have been announced.

The competition is the only one of its kind in the UK, raising awareness of Britain and Ireland's vulnerable native dog breeds and recognising those breeders and owners dedicated to ensuring their continued survival. In 2025, 39 breeds fell into this category, having generated 300 or fewer puppy registrations in the UK in the previous year.

The competition continues to prove very popular and at Crufts 2025, two-year-old Irish Wolfhound (Ch Caredig Mafioso), owned by Debbie Tebbutt, and handled by husband Roger Tebbutt, was chosen as the winner of the grand final, judged by Graham Hill.

The 2026 final at Crufts will be judged by Dr Ron James who is approved to award Challenge Certificates to more than 75 breeds across five groups. The finalists will parade at 17.40pm in the bp pulse LIVE arena on Friday 6 March at the NEC in Birmingham. Pre-judging will take place in hall 1, ring 8 from 2.30pm.

In order to qualify for the final, a dog must have won Best of Breed

at the group championship show designated by the Royal Kennel Club as the breed's qualifying show. We hope that visitors will support the finalists either in pre-judging on Friday afternoon or in the main arena at 5.40pm as many of these lesser known breeds could be the perfect fit for certain owner's lifestyles."

Junior handling champions set to shine

Top junior handlers from around the world are set to travel to Crufts at the NEC, Birmingham to take part in one of the world's leading junior handling competitions – the Joe Cartledge Memorial International Junior Handling competition.

On Friday 6 March 2026, the prestigious final will take place across two parts in the bp pulse LIVE arena. The first part will be from 8.30am-10am followed by the parade and final at 6.05pm.

The first winner of this competition – Tracie Laliberte from the USA – was crowned at Crufts in 1984, when just seven countries competed in the final. The competition has grown over the past 42 years with 37 countries now represented by their national champions.

The competitors are aged between 11 and 19 and the final is the peak of any young person's junior handling career. Each handler will not be competing with their own dogs, however they will be provided with a breed of their choice. On the morning of the final, they will have just one hour to get to know this dog before showcasing their handling skills and breed expertise with that dog in the main ring in front of the judge.

The competition will be judged by Adrian Hili from Malta who is no stranger to Crufts and the International Junior Handling final. He represented his country twice in 1999 and 2000 – going on to win the event overall in 2000 handling a Pointer. He has bred multiple champion Basset Hounds and Standard Long-haired Dachshunds with his parents and handled his own Basset Hound to win Best of Breed at Crufts in 2004. He has spent the past 25 years successfully handling other people's dogs from all groups and won more than 40 Best in Show awards in Malta and Europe.

Judge Adrian Hili has this advice to the finalists: "It's an honour to represent your country at this prestigious event and having competed in this competition before, I know how the young handlers will be feeling. Just relax and enjoy the moment and handle your dog with kindness and skill to ensure it is the star of the show."

Imported Register Breeds competing at Crufts 2026

The Royal Kennel Club has announced that an incredible 252 dogs will be competing in the Imported Breeds Register classes at Crufts 2026 over the four days. Experienced Utility and Working group and Best In Show judge, Mark James, has the honour of judging the AV Imported Register classes.

For the first time, the White Swiss Shepherd has drawn the largest number of dogs with 34 set to compete in the breed rings. For the past few years, Russian Toy Terriers have topped the Imported Register table but now they have been moved off the Imported Register - there is an incredible 60 Russian Toys entered in their own breed classes.

There are also three new breeds competing in the Imported Registered classes for the first time at Crufts: the Pyrenean Mastiff (4), Hungarian Mudi (13) and Icelandic Sheepdog (10).

Since 2018, the dog declared Best Any Variety Imported Breeds

Register has been eligible to compete in its relevant group competition at shows including Crufts, following a change to Royal Kennel Club regulations.

Tom Mather, Crufts Chairman, said:
