RKC hosts largest breeder insights forum to date

Event marks the launch of the new RKC Breeder Insights and Experience Survey to gather nationwide feedback from breeders of all kinds.

The Royal Kennel Club hosted its latest and largest Breeder Insights Forum on Monday 20 March, bringing together around 100 breeders from across the UK for a collaborative day focused on sharing experiences, discussing challenges and helping shape the future of breeder support. This forum marks the first event of its kind at this scale, following a smaller pilot session held in January with a group of around 15 breeders to gather early feedback.

The forum also marked the launch of the RKC Breeder Insights and Experience Survey, designed to better understand the experiences, challenges and needs of all dog breeders across purebred and crossbreed communities, and whether or not they are RKC registered. The findings will help the Royal Kennel Club strengthen its support for responsible breeding through practical, evidence based action.

Highlights from the day included engaging discussions on breeder experiences and challenges, as well as updates on the development of the new Nose to Tail veterinary assessment.

Breeders took part in small discussion



groups facilitated to explore their day to day experiences, the pressures faced within the current breeding landscape, and the opportunities they see for improvement. These conversations generated valuable feedback, ideas and lived perspectives, all of which will be reviewed and used to guide future planning and developments.

Participants also received an update on the development of the new Nose to Tail veterinary assessment, including progress made so far and details of what breeders can expect as the project continues.

To close the forum, the Royal Kennel Club confirmed it will follow up with further information on upcoming tools and support for breeders, and that this

marks the continuation of an ongoing conversation. The Royal Kennel Club would like to thank all those who attended for their valuable contributions.

Following the event, Charlotte McNamara, Chief Canine Wellbeing and Engagement Officer at the Royal Kennel Club said: "The purpose of the forum was to bring breeders together to openly share their experiences, challenges and ideas, and the day emphasised the Royal Kennel Club's commitment to ensuring breeder feedback directly informs ongoing development. All our attendees shared incredibly useful insight and expertise which remain essential to strengthening the RKC's work and future priorities."

Charlotte McNamara appointed as Chief Canine Wellbeing and Engagement Officer

The Royal Kennel Club has announced the appointment of Charlotte McNamara as its new Chief Canine Wellbeing and Engagement Officer.

Charlotte brings more than a decade of experience within the organisation, alongside a lifelong involvement in the canine community. Since joining the Royal Kennel Club in 2012, she has played a pivotal role in strengthening relationships with breed communities and advancing collaborative approaches to canine health and responsible breeding.

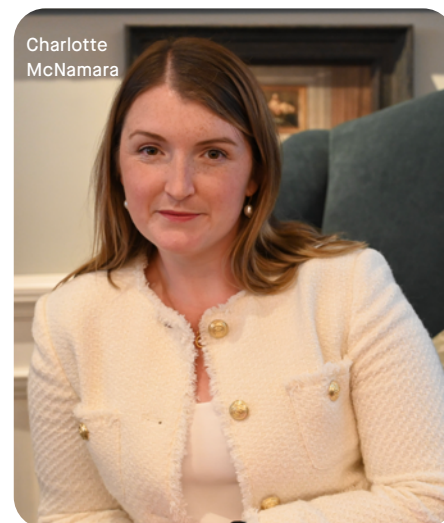
During her tenure, Charlotte has been instrumental in delivering several of the organisation's most significant health and welfare initiatives. These include the Respiratory Function Grading Scheme, developed in partnership with the University of Cambridge, the Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Heart Scheme, and the introduction of health entry requirements for Crufts 2025. Most recently, she has contributed to the development of the Royal Kennel Club's Breeding for Health Framework, reinforcing the organisation's leadership in canine welfare standards.

A respected figure within the dog world, Charlotte combines professional

expertise with deep personal credibility. She has extensive experience as an owner, breeder and judge across a range of pedigree breeds, and is a recognised spokesperson for the Royal Kennel Club, with media appearances spanning national broadcast outlets. In taking on this new role, Charlotte has chosen to step back from judging and exhibiting so that she can focus fully on serving the interests of the RKC and our communities. She will continue to breed very occasionally to maintain her kennel name, Lynbank, which carries important family significance.

In her new role, Charlotte will lead the organisation's strategic approach to canine wellbeing and engagement, activities, and governance, further strengthening its commitment to improving the health and welfare of dogs across the UK and internationally.

Miniature American Shepherd granted recognition by the RKC

Miniature American Shepherd



The Miniature American Shepherd will be recognised by the Royal Kennel Club with effect from 1 July 2026.

The breed will be classified in the Pastoral Group on the Imported Breed Register. Until such time as a Royal Kennel Club interim breed standard has been published, the Miniature American Shepherd is not eligible to compete at Royal Kennel Club licensed breed shows.

The Miniature American Shepherd originated in the United States as a compact and

highly versatile herding dog, prized for its intelligence, agility, and loyalty. Recognised by the American Kennel Club in 2011 and by the FCI in 2019, the breed has continued to grow in popularity and is now becoming increasingly established in the UK.

The Royal Kennel Club will recognise 227 breeds of pedigree dog from 1 July 2026 following the simultaneous recognition of the Yakutian Laika. The last breed to be recognised was the Hungarian Mudi in July 2025.

RKC launches 'The Dog People's Manifesto'

Calling on the incoming government to put dog health and welfare first with evidence-led agenda to protect Wales's dogs and their owners.

Ahead of the forthcoming Welsh election in May, the Royal Kennel Club (RKC) has launched The Dog People's Manifesto, a comprehensive set of policy priorities calling on an incoming Government to help dog owners across Wales acquire healthy dogs and care for their pets better.

With one in three Welsh homes having a dog, the Manifesto urges policymakers to recognise Wales's long-standing status as a dog loving nation and to back responsible ownership so it can thrive.

Speaking on the Manifesto, Jannine Edgar, chief executive of the Royal Kennel Club, said: "This Manifesto highlights the importance of responsible dog ownership and high-welfare breeding across Wales. Dogs make a real difference to people's physical and mental wellbeing, especially for those who may feel isolated or lonely. This is a call for practical, evidence-led policies that support better education for those looking to own a dog in the future. It is our intention to make this vision a reality for dogs and the people who love them."

The Dog People's Manifesto sets out a vision for practical, evidence-led policy that supports high-welfare dog breeding, tackles irresponsible practices and prioritises education over unintended regulatory consequences.

- **Responsible dog breeding:** Recognise hobby breeders - careful, home based breeders - as the backbone of Welsh breeding for over 150 years and develop a balanced licensing framework that supports,

not squeezes, the good. Prioritise practical, non regulatory steps to grow healthy, home bred puppies (buyer education, mentoring for new breeders, clear puppy contracts) and co design any changes with the community. Learn from England: excessive complexity shrinks well bred supply and fuels illegal puppy farming and low welfare imports.

- **Addressing puppy imports and genetic health:** While enforcement against illegal, low welfare imports has strengthened, the Manifesto warns that UK wide import rules risk harming genetic health in smaller breeds if they block non commercial, single puppy imports used to widen gene pools.

It asks the incoming Government to work with Defra on permit schemes that allow carefully controlled, non commercial imports where there is a clear genetic health benefit.

- **Improving the health of flat-faced breeds:** To tackle ongoing health challenges in brachycephalic breeds such as Pugs, Bulldogs and French Bulldogs, the Manifesto argues for moving beyond awareness messaging to health first breeding actions. It supports wider promotion and use of the internationally recognised Respiratory Function Grading scheme, developed with the University of Cambridge, to ensure breeding decisions put welfare first. It also encourages education for breeders

and puppy buyers on the advantages of the Respiratory Function Grading scheme and its importance for the health and welfare of their chosen dog breeds.

- **Rethinking dangerous dogs legislation:** The addition of the XL Bully type to the Dangerous Dogs Act has heightened anxiety among responsible owners and underlines the failure of breed specific legislation to prevent serious incidents. The Manifesto calls for an evidence led review based on behaviour rather than appearance, a greater focus on responsible ownership, early intervention and education, and better resourcing for police, local authorities and third sector partners-while noting dog owner licensing alone would not solve the issue.

- **Private and social rented housing:** Restrictive pet policies on both private and social rented accommodations are increasingly forcing responsible owners into a difficult choice between keeping their pet or securing a home. The Manifesto urges the next Welsh Government to take an inclusive, evidence led approach that recognises the proven social, health and economic benefits of pet ownership for tenants and communities. The Manifesto backs a full Bill to improve access to rented homes; introducing a right to request a pet that cannot be unreasonably refused, clear guidance on what constitutes reasonable grounds, protections throughout tenancies, and a 28 day maximum response time for landlords.

Jannine Edgar further commented: "As an organisation that reinvests entirely in improving dog health and welfare and supporting responsible breeds, we look forward to working constructively with the incoming Government to deliver lasting, positive change for dogs and their owners."

Vulnerable British and Irish Native Breeds Competition returns in 2026

Heats for the Royal Kennel Club Vulnerable British and Irish Native Breeds competition have begun to take place and, as in previous years, will culminate in a grand final at Crufts 2027.

The Royal Kennel Club launched the competition in 2015 to raise awareness of vulnerable British and Irish native breeds, as well as recognising those people who are dedicated to their survival and prosperity. In 2026, there are 38 breeds that fall into this category, having generated 300 or fewer puppy registrations in the UK in the previous year.

The competition continues to be popular at Crufts and in March 2026 a three-year-old Irish Wolfhound (Ch Caredig Mafioso), repeated his overall win from Crufts 2025. Tozie, owned by Debbie Tebbutt, and handled by husband Roger Tebbutt, was chosen as the Crufts 2026 winner, judged by Dr Ron James.

As in 2025, only the Best of Breed winners at designated championship shows this year will qualify for the final and the competition is open to all vulnerable British and Irish native breeds competing at the following championship shows:

- **28 March 2026**, United Kingdom Toydog Society
- **4 April 2026**, National Terrier Club
- **11 July 2026**, National Working and Pastoral Breeds Society
- **18 July 2026**, Hound Association
- **2 August 2026**, National Gundog Association

Dogs who win Best of Breed at the above shows and are on the Royal Kennel Club's Vulnerable British and Irish breeds list will qualify for the competition and will be invited to compete in the grand final at Crufts 2027. In cases where the Best of Breed winner is unable to compete in the final, the Best Opposite Sex winner will be invited.

Tom Mather, Crufts Chairman said: "The Vulnerable British and Irish Breeds competition final is a very important event at Crufts as it's a wonderful way to highlight just how special these vulnerable breeds are. We must support these lesser-known breeds as they could be the perfect fit for certain owner's lifestyles but

are being overlooked in favour of other breeds that might not be, simply because they are not as well-known.

"Good luck to those exhibitors competing with their vulnerable native breeds at the national group championship shows over the coming months."

Final date set for Junior Warrant semi-finals and National Junior Handler of the Year

The Royal Kennel Club has announced that the Junior Warrant semi-finals and the National Junior Handler of the Year finals will be taking place on Saturday 3 October 2026 at The Kennel Club Building, Stoneleigh, Warwickshire.

The Royal Kennel Club Junior Warrant Winner of the Year competition began in 1998 and sees Junior Warrant winners compete for the coveted title of Royal Kennel Club Junior Warrant Winner of the Year award. The competition is for dogs between the ages of 6-18 months who have qualified for a Junior Warrant within 1 June 2025 and 31 May 2026.

Qualifying heats for the Junior Warrant Winner of the Year competition will take place at designated open shows hosted by general canine societies across the UK between June - September 2026. These heats offer young dogs the opportunity to compete for a place in the prestigious semi-finals, with the final being held at Crufts 2027. Exhibitors are encouraged to check the list of upcoming qualifying shows and ensure they meet the eligibility criteria ahead of entry.

As introduced last year, a £10 entry fee per dog will be required for participation in the Junior Warrant competition semi-final. This fee has been introduced to help support the continued running and development of the competition.

The National Junior Handler of the Year final, organised by the Junior Handling Association, has been running since the 1970s and is one of the most hotly contested junior handling finals in the country, with the semi-final heats having taken place since December 2025 at group championship shows. The winners of these heats will take part in the final on 3 October,

Yakutian Laika granted recognition by the Royal Kennel Club

The Yakutian Laika (pronounced yuh-koo-tee-un) will be recognised by the Royal Kennel Club with effect from 1 July 2026.

The breed will be classified in the Working Group on the Imported Breed Register. Until such time as a Royal Kennel Club interim breed standard has been published, the Yakutian Laika is not eligible to compete at Royal Kennel Club licensed breed shows.

Rooted in the vast and demanding landscape of northeastern Russia, the Yakutian Laika is an ancient working breed shaped over millennia by its vital role in transport, hunting and daily

survival. Celebrated for its resilience, instinct, and unwavering devotion, the breed was carefully revived in the 1990s and formally recognised by the Russian Kynological Federation in 2004. Today, the Yakutian Laika stands as a striking, versatile companion whose popularity is steadily rising worldwide.

The Royal Kennel Club will recognise 227 breeds of pedigree dog from 1 July 2026 following the simultaneous recognition of the Miniature American Shepherd. The last breed to be recognised was the Hungarian Mudi in July 2025.

This month's Crufts special is packed with standout moments from the world's greatest dog show. A brand-new addition saw Hall 8 host the inaugural Crufts Dog Grooming Championship, sponsored by Artero, drawing impressive crowds, as we catch up with the first-ever Best Groomer in Show. Heelwork to music celebrates 20 years at Crufts, with insights from Mary Ray, who pioneered the discipline at the show, alongside Richard Curtis, plus reflections from this year's star performers. Meanwhile, a new dog display from His Majesty's Prison and Probation Service captivated audiences in the bp pulse LIVE arena. The Para-Obedience display in the Good Citizen Dog Training Scheme ring showcased handlers with a range of disabilities competing alongside their dogs, demonstrating how both adapted skilfully to the discipline.

In our Crufts report, we look at the show's strong international appeal, with 24 per cent of entries coming from overseas. Despite this global presence, Best in Show judge Dr Tamas Jakkel selected a home-bred Clumber Spaniel, 'Bruin', handled by Lee Cox - only the second time the breed has claimed the top honour.

Among the many memorable stories are exceptional canine and human partnerships. Norfolk Terrier 'Easy' claimed the Junior Warrant final in his owner's first time representing the breed, while Irish Wolfhound 'Tozie' secured a second consecutive victory

in the Royal Kennel Club's Vulnerable British and Irish Breeds competition. David and Roxanne Simms' Arcticskies Siberian Huskies triumphed in the Breeders' Competition to their surprise, having only competed once before and never been shortlisted, and flyball team Junkyard Dogs celebrated a long-awaited breakthrough, taking the title of Flyball Champions 2026. We meet the winners of the Young Royal Kennel Club competitions, the next generation thriving in their new Hall 8 home, and Labrador Retriever 'Clyde' won the Northesk Memorial Trophy and Best in Gamekeeper classes. Familiar faces in agility successfully held on to their titles once more, while others celebrated emotional first-time successes. Elsewhere, the Crufts Inter-Regional Rally Competition was won by the Wales team, who went one better than last year, and the Northern team claimed the Crufts Inter-Regional Obedience title in a close finish.

A comprehensive round-up highlights key developments from across the show: four breeds gained championship status, while an additional three appeared for the first time in the Imported Breed Register classes, alongside impressive figures demonstrating the event's popularity, including its most viral moments. The event also acknowledged the Kennel Club Charitable Trust, which works in partnership with Agria Pet Insurance, providing an annual donation based on the number of Royal Kennel Club Pet Insurance policies taken out. The Kennel Gazette also paid tribute to Royal Kennel Club member David Clark, who passed away following the show. He is remembered for his meticulous care of Crufts' historic trophies, including the Keddell Memorial Trophy, which celebrated its 100th anniversary last year. The health team engaged directly with breeders through daily Q&As, while public affairs activity ensured strong engagement with visiting politicians. The Crufts Sustainable Exhibitor Awards, sponsored by Agria Pet Insurance,

returned for a second year, celebrating environmentally responsible businesses.

We meet the winners of the Best Discover Dogs Stand in each group, including the overall winner and runner-up, recognising the enthusiasm and dedication of the teams who welcome visitors and promote responsible dog ownership. Breed club stands also drew attention, with the winners of the Best Breed Club Stand in each group acknowledging their creativity and commitment. These clubs work tirelessly beside the rings where their breeds are shown, decorating their stands to attract visitors from the UK and overseas.

Arena displays continued to inspire, with Medical Detection Dogs demonstrating life-changing work in identifying over 30 medical conditions, including recent advances in detecting bowel cancer and serious infections. West Midlands Police delivered a high-energy display featuring their confident young F1 litter, named after Formula 1 drivers and tracks, while working gundogs showcased their skills. We also talk to photographers Yulia Titovets and Lisa Croft-Elliott, who captured more than 33,500 images in the arena, and share their favourite moments.

It's clear that this year's show was a resounding success, underlined by strong attendance and engagement. Crufts remains a must-see celebration for dog lovers everywhere, with unforgettable moments for all.
